Recommendation

Staff respectfully requests City Council consider and award the bid to replace the recreation building furnace to J&J Heating and Air for the bid amount of \$5485.00 and approve supplemental appropriation Resolution No. 2024-R-004, "A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF GRIDLEY AUTHORIZING THE REPLACEMENT OF THE FURNACE IN THE GRIDLEY RECREATION BUILDING AND APPROPRIATON OF SUPPLEMENTAL FUNDS", by reading of title only.

Background

On February 2nd, 2024, staff discovered that the furnace controlling the main Recreation Multi-Purpose Room (Bingo Room) was not working. On February 6th, 2024, staff arranged for a technician to come out and advised as to the needed repair on one of the main furnace heating components, the Inducer Fan Assembly. Recreation Coordinator partnered with the City Administrator as well as the Finance Director regarding repair recommendations. Three bids were acquired from the following companies: The Yeti Company, J &J Heating and Air, and Duncans Heating & Air.

Bid Summary

HVAC Company	Total Cost
Duncans Heating & Air	\$5,200.00
J&J Heating and Air	\$5,485.00
The Yeti Company	\$6,278.37

The recommendation is to award the contract to J & J Heating and Air due to their project transparency, quick response for inspection, and immediate availability for questions through the bidding process.

Financial Impact

The Financial impact this repair/replacement would require a supplemental appropriation because this was an unforeseen circumstance and was not included in the budget for FY 23/24. The carbon credit fund #928 will fund the repair. These funds have been used in the past for HVAC repairs/replacements.

Compliance with City Council Strategic Plan or Budget Goals

Replacing the furnace will minimally impact the Strategic Plan and Budget goals. The HVAC replacement is crucial in the continued day-to-day operation of the Recreation Department.

Recommendation

Staff respectfully requests the City Council review services and provide input as to preferences of potential program offerings.

Background

Efficiency Services Group (ESG) is a consulting group which has provided the following services to the City of Gridley for over 20 years. These programs are designed to save energy, provide customer value and meet the tracking and reporting requirements of the Public Benefits (PB) Program established for publicly owned utilities under Public Utilities Code Section 385.

CURRENT ENERGY EFFICIENCY PROGRAM OFFERING

- Program Hotline provide toll free number for the intake of program inquiries from customers and contractors; staffed Monday-Friday 8 am – 5 pm, except company holidays.
- Rebate Processing review customer applications from all rate classes (including requests for custom rebates), enter in database, and submit to City for payment processing.
- Administration maintain forms and procedures to ensure required data is collected and available to assure compliance with legislative guidelines/requirements.
- Field Support provide on-site field support for commercial customers who upgrade lighting, HVAC, and process equipment; conduct scoping/walk-thru audits for large commercial and industrial customers; conduct residential audits in response to high bill complaints.
- Program Management program design consulting; development of new offers, technical review of measures to maximize reportable savings, customer participation and cost-effectiveness; suggest programs to help the City meet or exceed their legislated EE goals.
- Reporting send reports detailing program activity (participating customers, rebates and savings) for the current month, year-to-date and program-to-date.
- Regulatory Compliance perform all reporting necessary to comply with statutory requirements, including: SB1037 (data and program narrative reports) and AB2021 (10-Year Target Setting). Provide data to support EIA 861and other reports upon request.
- NCPA Support attend monthly Demand Management Workgroup meeting and communicate key information to the City as it relates to the management, delivery and compliance of energy efficiency and renewable energy programs.

- Outreach facilitate opportunities to partner with regional efforts of other NCPA utilities.
- Third Party Program Oversight ensure program requirements are met and program compliance is documented, including field and data verification.

UPCOMING PROGRAM UPDATES

Digital Forms

- ESG has prepared digital forms to be linked to the City's website. The design of these forms focused on customer experience and ensuring the most up-to-date information available to the customer on program offering and requirements.
- ESG will work with the City to post these digital forms to the City's website for customer
 use.

Program Flyer

- ESG will design and prepare for the City an informational program flyer to be used as a bill stuffer or to be available to be handed out in the office.
- Spanish Translation is available upon request.
- The flyer will help to promote the program and let the community members know about available offerings.

POTENTIAL PROGRAM OFFERINGS

Residential Direct Install

- This program provides the free installation of energy-saving direct install measures (DIMs)directly in customer homes. This program is a great resource for renters and customers with fixed or limited income who are unable to participate in the standard rebate program due to financial constraints or the inability to make permanent changes to a rental property.
- The program can include LED lightbulbs, load-sensing power strips, faucet aerators and high-performance shower heads. Smart Thermostats can also be included for handout at the customer's request.
- ESG and our installation partner provide all marketing, educational, and customer relations collateral to explain benefits and applications of installed measures, promote other utility programs, and strengthen relationships with customers.
- This program will provide reportable energy savings for the City.
- While in the customer home installing DIMs, ESG can also acquire valuable data on customer equipment that can be used to develop future program offerings.

Commercial Direct Install Program

- ESG is currently offering a commercial direct install program in other utility service territories.
- The program helps commercial customers upgrade their existing inefficient lighting to LED lighting.
- The program provides free fixtures to participating customers.
- The program provides energy savings that can contribute to the City's annual energy efficiency targets.

Electric Vehicle Program

- ESG can easily add additional rebate offerings to the current program to support the adoption of electric vehicles.
- Potential offerings include rebates for residential and commercial EV chargers and/or purchase of new or used electric vehicles.
- ESG is available to assist the City with participation in the California Air Resources Board's Low Carbon Fuel Standard Program upon request.

Water Savings Program

- ESG can easily add additional water-savings offerings into the current program structure. ESG is currently providing similar offerings in other utility programs.
- For example, adding a rebate for water saving toilets would be a great way to help customers save water at home.

Financial Impact

The consulting and programs are funded through the public benefit program (610), based on the program offering. Based on the direction from Council relating to which programs to offer, staff will provide supplement appropriation requests in a future meeting as the potential program costs estimates once they are provided by consultant.
