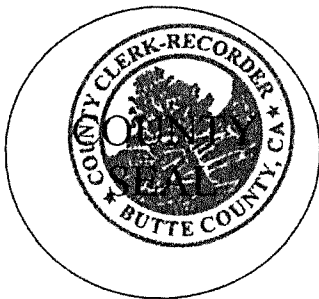

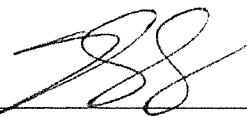

Tentative Subdivision Map 2-19 was provided the maximum amount of time under the Subdivision Map Act (Govt Code §66452.6) and would have expired on December 2, 2024 if the developer had not submitted a letter requesting legislative action to extend the tentative map in accordance with the provision of Subdivision Map Act 66452.6(e)(a). This code section allows the City Council to consider and extend the map for up to six years beyond the allowable time under Govt Code §66452.6.

Staff is requesting the City Council's direction to support the requested extension in which case it would return to the City Council at its January 2025 hearing date. If the City Council does not support the extension, then the map will expire and the developer will be required to re-apply to the city.

Discussion

Project Approvals/Status

On August 5, 2019 the developer submitted an application to develop a ±5.4 acre into residential development. The requested entitlements were a General Plan Amendment, a Rezone, and a Tentative Subdivision Map to create 42 single-family parcels. The application was reviewed internally and proceeded to be reviewed by the Planning Commission.

The project was scheduled for September 18, 2019; however, that meeting was cancelled. On October 16, 2019, the Planning Commission reviewed the project and recommended the City Council approve of and adopt resolutions and an ordinance supporting the project.

On December 2, 2019, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 2019-R-035 approving the Tentative Subdivision Map No. 2-19 (TSM 2-19) to create a 42-parcel single-family residential development on ±5.4 acres. This resolution also approved of the General Plan Amendment to

change from Residential, Very Low Density to Residential, Medium Density land use designation. The adopted resolution also accepted the Initial Study/Mitigated Negative Declaration to satisfy the CEQA evaluation and filed the Notice of Determination with the Butte County Recorder. The City Council also approved the first reading and adoption of Ordinance 832-2019 which rezoned the property from Residential Suburban (R-S) to Single-Family Residential District (R-1); the second reading of the ordinance was subsequently adopted by the City Council effecting the zone change 30 days after the second reading.

After the approvals, the applicant submitted plans for construction and underwent the plan check process for the project. After the review of the improvement and site development plans, a grading permit (GR 02-21) for rough grading was approved and issued on October 25, 2021 by letter dated September 21, 2021. This permit allowed the project to proceed while additional review of the infrastructure and state variance applications were processed. Between the time of the entitlements being approved by the City Council and the grading permit issuance, the impacts of COVID-19 increased all construction costs, reduced available labor and construction expertise to move forward with all of the projects. Though not a part of the grading plan, during this time, the temporary reduction (2019-R-028 (approved October, 2019)) of development impact fees sunset and were no longer available to the developer who had developed their proforma based on these reductions. The development impact fee reduction ended December 31, 2022. According to the developer, the increase from the reduction of \$7,308.64 to \$29,234.55 was a significant impact to the estimated costs of development as well.

The final grading approval was ready to be issued June 15, 2023 as GR02-23 to allow the completion of all components and construction of the site in preparation of the construction of the first model home, filing of the final subdivision map, and vertical build for the subdivision.

Developer's Request

The developer submitted a letter, Attachment 1, to the city prior to the expiration of TSM 2-19 requesting the City Council extend the map for an additional 4 years to December 2, 2028. A letter from Matt Stapley has outlined reasons for the City Council to support this request:

- The Developer has expended approximately \$2,000,000 on improvements to the site;
- There is a housing crisis that supports the extension to be able to complete the project; and,
- The Developer remains committed to meeting all of the conditions set forth in the original agreement.

Subdivision Map Act Government Code §66452.6 (c)(a)

The Subdivision Map Act Government Code §66452.6 (a)(1) defines the expiration and extensions of maps. Generally, maps are approved for a period of two years and if more time is needed an extension is requested.

The Gridley Municipal Code allows the Planning Commission to extend the approvals of Tentative Maps.

Subdivision Map Act Government Code §66452.6 (e)(a) allows a further extension of a Tentative Map by a legislative body, the City Council. This section of the code has been reviewed by the City Attorney who concurs this section applies and can be used by the City Council to extend the map to the date requested by the Developer to December 2, 2028.

Public Noticing

A public notice was placed in the Gridley Herald 10 days in advance; however, it was not quite accurate in the description for the consideration by the City Council. In this case, staff is requesting direction from the City Council and not a decision, therefore, although it is not quite accurate, it does notice the request for direction regarding the project.

Notices were mailed to the surrounding property owners within a 300-foot radius of the subject site, posted at City Hall, and on the city website. At the time this report was prepared, no comments had been received.

Conclusion

Staff is requesting direction from the City Council to return with a resolution to extend TSM 2-19 for the requested four years to December 2, 2028.

The request by the applicant to the legislative body-City Council- is not a typical process; however, it does provide the city with a tool to support a project that has been previously approved, and has not been able to complete the project to begin vertical build due to various economic and other factors. Providing a four-year extension to December 2, 2028, will allow the developer more time to complete the project which will provide needed housing in the city. Without an extension, additional costs would be incurred to apply again for the same project.

Environmental Review

The process to extend a Tentative Subdivision Map does not require additional CEQA review, because that review was done for the originally approved project.

Financial Impact

There are no direct costs to the City for the extension of the TPM other than the cost for staff to meet with the developer, set a hearing date, advertise the public notice, mail notices, and prepare this City Council Report

Compliance with City Council Strategic Plan or Budget Goals

This recommendation is consistent with the ongoing effort to be transparent regarding all land use planning matters.

We had a productive and positive meeting with City Administrator, Elisa Arteaga, last week and discussed in further emails the contents of the email below. On her recommendation, we are sending this request to your attention, which we believe to be straightforward. Should you have any questions, please don't hesitate to contact us:

We are writing to formally request to be considered at the next city council meeting, an extension of the subdivision improvement agreement for The Village at Eagle Meadows, pursuant to the Subdivision Map Act, specifically California Government Code Section 66452.6. We have spent approximately \$2,000,000 to date on improvements both on site and off site and request a 4-year extension amendment to the current subdivision agreement in place.

The current agreement, which was approved on December 2, 2019, is set to expire on December 2, 2024. We have made this request to the City previously on October 4, 2024 and received correspondence from Donna Decker, that the map was going to expire and offered no solutions or relief, thus it is our understanding the current city official position, in writing (see below), is that we are just "out of luck". We respectfully disagree with this position. We have since met with City Administrator Arteaga and understand that the City is in the midst of making some staff changes. We appreciate her willingness to work with us, and our meeting was positive and refreshing based on her attitude that there is a way to move forward that will be mutually beneficial. Staffing matters aside, we have a project map to preserve. Since receiving Donna's correspondence, we have learned from other experienced professionals that there are provisions in the State law that allow and contemplate these types of situations.

Considering the current housing crisis in the State, and the various laws being passed to encourage housing, coupled with a housing element that is not in compliance, we believe this remedy is a benefit to both the City and our needs.

In accordance with Section 66452.6, which allows for the extension of the time limit for the completion of improvements, We respectfully request an extension of 4 years to December 2nd, 2028. This extension will enable us to fulfill all the necessary requirements and ensure the successful completion of the project.

We remain committed to meeting all the conditions set forth in the original agreement and appreciate your understanding and consideration of this request. It's imperative that this be considered prior to

the upcoming expiration. We hereby request the City adopt a simple and straightforward City Resolution extending the current subdivision improvement agreement an additional 4 years to an expiration date of Dec. 2nd, 2028 at the next available city council meeting. We will be in attendance at this meeting to answer any questions you may have.

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Project Site

The project site is located at the south side of Sycamore Street, east of Palm Lane. The site is currently vacant. The tentative subdivision map will create a 42 small lot subdivision for new single-family residential units. This model will allow an affordable by design unit with two-story homes ranging from 1,900 square feet to 2,250 square feet.

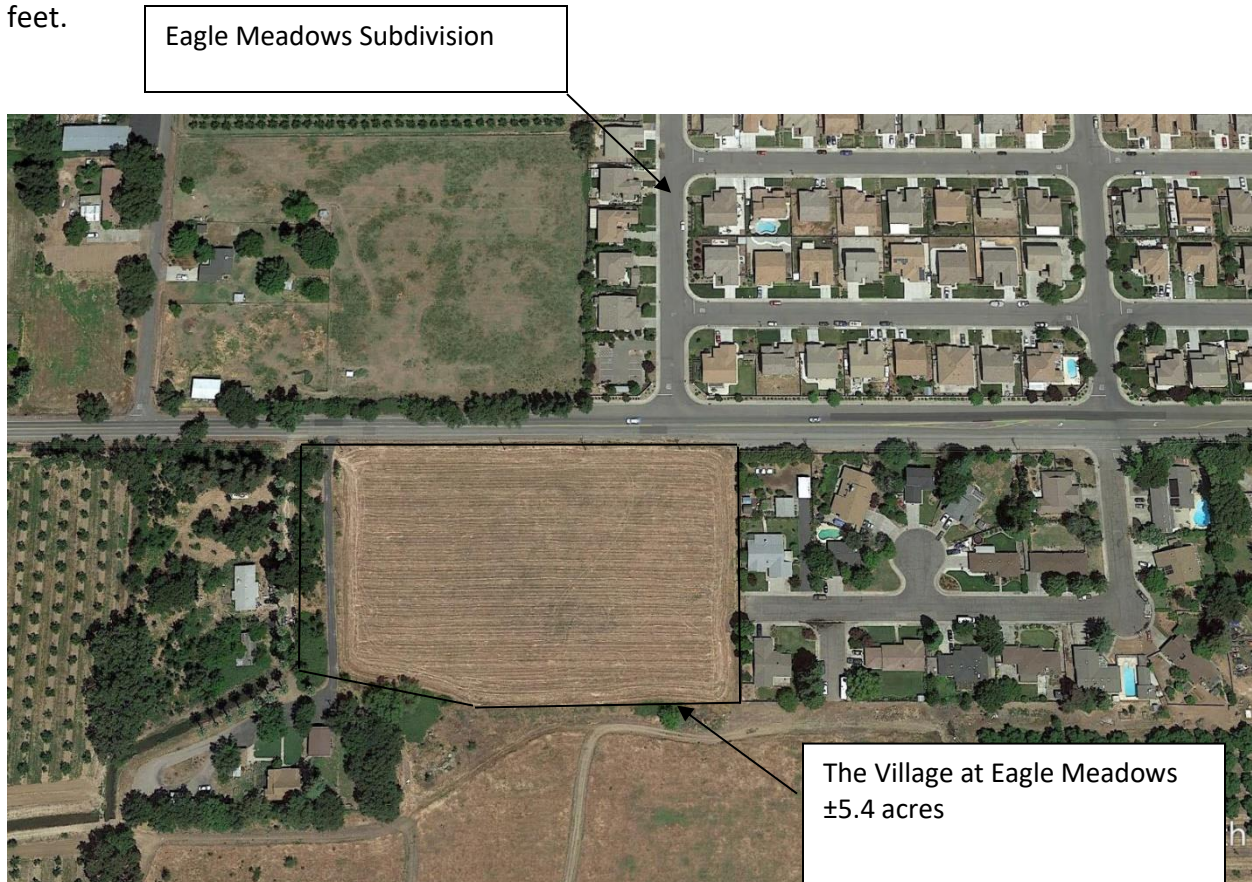


FIGURE 1: Project Location

Land Use

The project site is currently zoned Single-Family Residential District (R-1) and the General Plan Land Use Designation is Residential. The Single-Family Residential District has four (4) designations:

1. R-1A Parcels sized from 1,700 – 3,500 square feet
2. R-1B Parcels sized from 3,501 – 5,999 square feet
3. R-1C Parcels sized from 6,000 – 7,499 square feet
4. R-1 Parcels sized from 7,500 and greater

This project would have an R-1A zoning allowing lots to be from 1,700 sf to 3,500 square feet. These designations were developed to legalize many of the older City of Gridley lots so that each lot became legal and could be upgraded and maintained. These two R-1 designations allow for reduced setbacks from 0-3 feet. The rear yard setback remains at 5 feet. The design

allows meeting the demand for a standard single-family home without large lot areas to maintain. This has become a model that is highly desirable and provides a different housing product for our community.

Below , Figure 2, is the approved Tentative Subdivision Map 2-19 overlaid on a 2019 aerial.



FIGURE 2: Tentative Subdivision Map

The layout provides graphic as to how the homes will fit on the lots. There is adequate on-site parking for each unit and the street is designed to meet our subdivision standards for residential street design.

The Housing Element Policy HP-2.4 also supports this development:

“The City will encourage infill development in meeting the housing needs required by expanding populations.”

The road network provides access to the property and neighborhood connectivity to the south (Pacific Flyway) for future development.

Subject: Vermont Street ROW Vacation to Gridley Unified School District

Recommendation

City staff respectfully recommends that the City Council pass a Resolution vacating the 80-foot wide public right-of-way known as Vermont Street bound between Sycamore Street and Magnolia Street.

Background

Vermont Street runs between two parcels owned by the Gridley Unified School District, which in turn divides the Sycamore Middle School Campus and the McKinley Public School Campus. 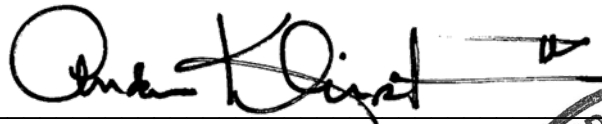

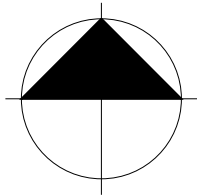

Recommendation

The Police Department respectfully requests the City Council to consider authorizing the purchase of 5 ergonomic chairs for the Police Department. Once purchased, the amount spent on the new chairs will be reimbursed from the Cities Risk Management Reserve Fund through Northern California Cities Self Insurance Fund (NCCSIF).

Background

Upon being appointed Chief of Police, I conducted an inspection of office chairs throughout the police department and found many of the chairs being utilized, were over 10 years old, badly worn and in need of immediate replacement. Our Public Safety Dispatchers are using the chairs 24/7 in the dispatch center. Additionally, Officers are in constant use of them as well when authoring their police reports.

In discussions with the Cities insurance company, it was recommended to solicit a quote from Body Bilt for ergonomic chairs. The proposed replacements are ergonomic chairs that have a ten year warranty.

Fiscal Impact

The cost of 5 ergonomic chairs is fully reimbursable by NCCSIF, no financial impact.
