Additional Considerations

- Separated sidewalk with landscape area
- Landscape planting and irrigation rough Estimate \$0.75M to \$1.0M
- Mid-Segment 3 improvements Spruce St. to Mini Storage
 - Caltrans working on cost increase
- North Segment considerations
 - Lighting
 - Landscape
 - May have ROW constraints
- Crossings
 - Dollar General
 - Ford Ave

Staff Recommendation

- Continuous ADA compliant 8 ft separated sidewalk/bike access from W. Liberty to Rio Pluma
- 4 ft landscaping area
 - Ornamental trees
 - Water tolerant ground cover
 - Irrigation
 - Lighting
- Timing is in alignment with multiple Federal, State, and local objectives and initiatives
 - Increasing Pedestrian and Bicycle facilities
 - Reduction of green house gasses
 - Climate Action Plan for Transportation Infrastructure





Goals for Council at Next Meeting

- Determine and decide what the City wants the streetscape corridor to look like as the 'front door" to Gridley
 - Important to get included in the scope environmental documents by Caltrans
 - City engagement early in design
- Commit to engagement with BCAG and other agencies to identify a financial plan that will be accepted by Caltrans
 - May include planning documents that meet BCAG RTP/SCS
 - Apply for BCAG programming (CMAQ)
 - May include applying for ATP Cycle 6 funding (joint application)
- Commit to provide up to \$500,000 in funding for construction in 2024
 - Allows for saving program to fund the project
