- 6. Applicant (and all guests thereof) shall defend and indemnify, hold harmless and release the City of Gridley, its officers, agents, employees, officials and volunteers of and from any and all claims resulting from the use of privileges granted by this application.
- 7. Cardholder agrees to immediately report to the City any violation of its rules at the City's boat ramp and to cooperate with prosecution of violators.
