- Good physical and mental health as required by POST standards

Application and Selection Procedure:

Lateral applicants must submit a completed application package, which includes City Application, Resume, and a copy of all POST Certificate(s). Academy graduates must submit a completed application packet, which includes City Application, Resume, POST Academy Certificate and a copy of T-Scores and Academy Ranking, to the City of Gridley, 685 Kentucky Street, Gridley, CA 95948. The testing process could include a written test along with an oral board interview. Selected candidates must pass a psychological evaluation, a physical examination, and a background investigation.
