The level of service of recycling and yard waste carts/totes is at the discretion of the City's solid waste franchisee.

TITLE 15. BUILDINGS and CONSTRUCTION

A. BUILDING PERMITS

- I. GENERAL PROVISIONS The following general provisions shall apply to all fees for all Building, Mechanical, Plumbing and Electrical Permits as established in subsequent subsections of this Fee Schedule.
 - A. Investigation Fees – Work Prior to Issuance of a Permit The Permit fees established herein shall be doubled if the permit is obtained after commencement of work. Investigation above and beyond the standard time allotted shall be charged at the basic hourly rate.
 - B. Hourly Fees
 1. All hourly fees set forth herein shall have a minimum fee of the rate for one hour, unless otherwise noted.
 2. For work in excess of one hour, the fee shall be prorated for each quarter hour or portion thereof.
 - C. Plan Review and/or Inspection Fees for Work not Covered in the Following Fee Schedule:
 1. Basic Fee \$99.30/hour
 2. Permit Issuance Fee – cost to issue each Building, Mechanical, Plumbing, Electrical, Demolition and Public Benefit Energy Inspection Permit. \$30.00/each
 3. After-Hours Fee – When Staff is requested by applicant to work after-hours to complete a plan review and/or inspections (subject to Staff availability) – minimum charge – 2 hours. \$150.00/hour
 4. Construction Inspection Fee – to cover the costs incurred in responding to more than two requests for inspection at a construction site to inspect the same work item. \$50.00/inspection
 5. Voluntary Housing and Building Inspections – to cover the cost of inspections when requested by owner, realtor, purchaser or other party to determine compliance with applicable codes. \$99.30/hour, w/half hour minimum
 - D. Plan Review and Permit Fees
 1. The Building Official may authorize the refund of plan review and permit fees pursuant to circumstances as set forth in Chapter 1 of the 2001 California Building Code.
 2. The fees in effect at the time of submitting plans and specifications for review shall

remain valid provided a building permit is obtained with six (6) months of plan review application.

- E. Other For Building Department services not addressed in this fee schedule, the Building Official shall make a determination of the appropriate fee based on actual costs for such services.

II. BUILDING PERMIT FEES

A. Plan Review/Administrative Fees

1. Preliminary Plan Review Fee – this fee is applicable for review of preliminary plans submitted for a building project. This review is cursory and should not be interpreted as a full review. Preliminary plan reviews may be submitted for properties located outside the City limits for which annexation is being considered.

Building Permit Fees – the fees for each Building, Mechanical, Plumbing and Electrical permit shall be as set forth in the 1997 Uniform Administrative Code with modifications as noted in Sections III, IV, V & VI below: **The Construction Cost Index (CCI), or its successor, published in January for December of the previous year shall be the index used in determining any rate change. The initial CCI for the purposes of this fee is 6825 as published in the January 2004 Engineering News Record.*

Any change in the December-to-December CCI will be reflected in the fee schedule the following February.

2. Strong Motion Instrumentation Fee – in addition to the fee for each building permit as set forth above, the following fees shall be collected in order to comply with the State of California Department of Conservation, Strong-Motion Instrumentation Program, in accordance with Section 2705 of the California Public Resources Code.
- a) Residential Occupancies (no more than three stories in height) – an amount equal to .01 percent of the established construction valuation as reported on the building permit, unless modified in accordance with Section 2705 of the California Public Resources Code.
 - b) All Other Occupancies – an amount equal to .021 percent of the established construction valuation as reported on the building permit, unless modified in accordance with Section 2705 of the California Public Resources Code.
3. Permit Fees for Other Categories of Work
- a) Demolition Permit Fee \$50.00
 - b) Conditional Occupancy Permit actual time, w/one hour

- III. BUILDING PERMIT FEES The fees for each building permit shall be as set forth in Table 3-A of the 1997 Uniform Administrative Code with the following modifications:
- A. The permit issuance fee shall be thirty dollars (\$30.00).
 - B. The minimum permit fee shall be thirty dollars (\$30.00), and fees greater than this amount shall be unchanged.
- IV. MECHANICAL PERMIT FEES The fees for each mechanical permit shall be as set forth in Table 3-C of the 1997 Uniform Administrative Code with the following modifications:
- A. The permit issuance fee shall be thirty dollars (\$30.00).
 - B. The minimum permit fee for the installation or relocation of any furnace shall be thirty dollars (\$30.00).
 - C. The minimum permit fee for the installation or relocation of any boiler or compressor up to 15 horsepower, or absorption system up to 500,000 Btu/hr, shall be thirty dollars (\$30.00), and fees for larger boilers, compressors or absorption systems shall be unchanged.
 - D. The fee for each complete residential heating, ventilation and air-conditioning system, including all heaters, compressors, fans, ducting and thermostats, shall be three dollars and sixty cents (\$3.60) per square foot.
 - E. The fee for each complete commercial or industrial heating, ventilation and air-conditioning system, including all heaters, compressors, fans, ducting and thermostats, shall be one and five tenths percent (1.5%) of the contract price.
- V. PLUMBING PERMIT FEES The fees for each plumbing permit shall be as set forth in Table 3-D of the 1997 Uniform Administrative Code with the following modifications:
- A. The permit issuance fee shall be thirty dollars (\$30.00).
 - B. The fee for each building sewer and each trailer park sewer shall be thirty dollars (\$30.00).
 - C. The fee for each water heater shall be twenty-five dollars (\$25.00).
 - D. The fee for each gas-piping system of one to five outlets shall be thirty dollars (\$30.00).
 - E. The fee for each industrial waste pretreatment interceptor including its trap and vent, except kitchen-type grease interceptors functioning as fixture traps, shall be thirty dollars (\$30.00).
 - F. The fee for each complete commercial or industrial plumbing system, including building sewer, water service, water & gas supply lines, waste & vent lines, valves and interceptors, shall be one and five tenths percent (1.5%) of the contract price.
- VI. ELECTRICAL PERMIT FEES The fees for each electrical permit shall be as set forth in the Table 3-B of the 1997 Uniform Administrative Code with the following modifications:
- A. The permit issuance fee shall be thirty dollars (\$30.00).

- B. The fee for each complete electrical system serving an in-ground swimming pool shall be ninety-five dollars (\$95.00).
- C. The fee for a temporary power service pole or pedestal, including all pole or pedestal-mounted receptacle outlets and appurtenances shall be forty dollars (\$40.00).
- D. The fee for electrical services of 600 volts or less and not over 200 amperes in rating shall be forty dollars (\$40.00).
- E. The fee for electrical wiring, excluding service panels, panels and sub-panels, at minor accessory buildings on residential properties shall be fifteen cents (\$0.15) per square foot.
- F. The fee for electrical wiring systems in commercial and industrial buildings, including services, panels, sub-panels and fixed appliances, shall be one and seventy-five one-hundredths percent (1.75%) of the contract price.

VII. EFFECTIVE DATE All fees set forth above, except those that are in conflict with fees stated in Title 15 of the Gridley Municipal Code, shall become effective on July 7, 2004.

The following fees are in conflict with portions of Title 15 and shall become effective thirty (30) days after revisions to Title 15 are adopted:

- A. The proposed thirty-dollar (\$30.00) permit issuance fee conflicts with the twenty-dollar (\$20.00) fee currently listed in GMC 15.04.210.E (Table No. 1-A Other Inspections and Fees).
- B. Building and Electrical fees for swimming pools listed in Section III and VI above conflict with the building and electrical permit fees for a swimming pool listed in GMC 15.04.610.A (Section 1.11 Fees).

For those applications requiring payment of a filing fee, such fee is assumed to cover all processing costs except in extraordinary cases. When an application requires payment of a deposit, the applicant is responsible for payment of all costs related to processing. Depending on the actual costs, additional payment may be required or excess funds refunded.

Environmental Review

The fee depends upon whether the project is exempt from CEQA (California Environmental Quality Act) or has the potential to result in impacts to the environment. A separate fee of \$36.00 (payable to Butte County) for all applications requiring environmental review is required by the County of Butte for the filing fee of environmental documents. For those projects which are not exempt and which are determined to have an impact on fish and wildlife or their habitat, an additional fee will be required.

For those applications requiring payment of a filing fee, such fee is assumed to cover all processing costs except in extraordinary cases. When an application requires payment of a deposit, the applicant is responsible for payment of all costs related to processing. Depending on the actual costs, additional payment may be required or excess funds refunded.

Environmental Review

The fee depends upon whether the project is exempt from CEQA (California Environmental Quality Act) or has the potential to result in impacts to the environment. A separate fee (currently \$36.00, payable to Butte County) for all applications requiring environmental review is required by the County of Butte for the filing fee of environmental documents. For those projects which are not exempt and which are determined to have an impact on fish and wildlife or their habitat, an additional fee will be required.
