Council came out of closed session and Attorney Galyean announced the following action: By a unanimous vote of 4-0, the Gridley City Council has accepted the resignation of Mr. Paul Eckert as City Administrator. In furtherance of Mr. Eckert’s gradual separation from the City of Gridley, effective immediately and through November 30, 2020, Mr. Eckert will be on paid Administrative leave, working remotely, during which time he will continue to focus on administration of critical city services, while laying the groundwork for a smoother transition to a successor. Mr. Eckert’s formal date of separation will be November 30, 2020.
